The Heartsaver Adult/Child/Infant courses have no prerequisites.

Students **MUST** hold a current certification from: American Heart Association Healthcare Provider CPR, American Red Cross BLS Healthcare Provider or Professional Rescuer certification, Military Training Network CPR certification, or Heart and Stroke Foundation of Canada BLS for Healthcare Provider. No exceptions.

Course Descriptions

The American Heart Association recognizes all AHA CPR & First Aid certificates for 2 years.

Heartsaver CPR/AED Adult/Child/Infant - The Heartsaver CPR Course is designed to teach CPR and foreign-body airway obstruction to all citizens, particularly those who are expected to respond to emergencies in the workplace. The Adult/Child Course teaches the basic techniques of adult and child CPR and use of an AED. Although, the course may be used to teach CPR to anyone, it is specifically designed for lay rescuers who are required to obtain a course completion card – a credential – documenting completion of a CPR course.

Healthcare Provider CPR – Completion / Renewal- The BLS for Healthcare Providers Course covers core material such as adult and pediatric CPR (including two-rescuer scenarios and use of the bag mask), foreign-body airway obstruction, and automated external defibrillation. The participants may include (but are not limited to) physicians, nurses, paramedics, emergency medical technicians, respiratory therapists, physician’s assistants, residents or fellows or medical or nursing students in training, aides, medical or nursing assistants and other allied health personnel.

First Aid – The Heartsaver First Aid Course teaches how to manage illness and injuries in the first few minutes until professional help arrives. Course content includes General Principles, Medical Emergencies, and Injury Emergencies. Optional topics include CPR/AED. Some rescuers are required to take this course as part of their employer’s effort to comply with OSHA (Occupational Safety and Health Administration) regulations.
